

Historic Triangle Democrats

January 16, 2025

Chair Jen Tierney opened the meeting @ 7:00pm and reminded the group that we have a lot to do in 2025.

Treasurer Jim Icenhour reported our finances: \$5,645 in our Federal Account, \$29,638 in our State Account. We raised over \$120,000 this year, the most we have ever raised.

We had record participation by volunteers and our localities were among the very few in Virginia to increase the Democratic share of the vote over 2020.

Jim Icenhour's financial report was approved.

On Saturday January 18, 2025 we are having our first petition signing event for our candidates for Virginia Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General and House of Delegates, as well as local candidates for James City County Board of Supervisors and WJCC school board. We are looking for a school board candidate for Jamestown District.

A gathering is planned for Thursday, Jan. 23 from 6-7:30pm at Tabb Library to plan for our work in York County and Poquoson in 2025. Narielle Living is organizing this activity.

The monthly Poquoson Democrats' dinner will be on February 13 at Anna's Italian Pizza at 6:30pm.

We have two positions open on the Historic Triangle Democrats Executive Committee: Vice Chair for Poquoson and Secretary. Cory Buttram has resigned; many thanks to her for her service.

W&M Professor John McGlennon joined us to discuss what to expect in 2025, as Republicans take over the White House and both houses of Congress and as we prepare for our fight to win the Virginia governorship and maintain and expand our majority in the General Assembly.
